COURSE CONTENT

ISM Code, the International Safety Management Code was made mandatory through the new chapter IX of the 1994 amendments to the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS).

Form the ISM Code item 4: "To ensure the safe operation of each ship and to provide a link between the Company and those on board, every Company, as appropriate, should designate a person or persons ashore having direct access to the highest level of management."

ISM Code in IMO resolutions, recognize the need for appropriate organization of management to enable it to respond to the need of those on board ships to achieve and maintain high standards of safety and environmental protection.

The Committees also agreed that there was an urgent need to provide guidance to shipping companies on the qualifications, training and experience for undertaking the role of Designated Person under provisions of the International Safety Management.

The companies shall ensure their full understanding on what the DP is actually supposed to do.

It must be very clear the role, function and responsibilities of the DP and the potential consequences if these are not performed efficiently and effectively.

In regard to the revised requirements of the ISM Code and recommendations of IMO, what are the responsibilities and authority of my company? What are the Master's responsibilities and authority on board the ship? How to implement and maintain the safety and environmental protection policy of the company onshore and onboard each ship? How to develop safety plans for shipboard operations? How to ensure that my company management system for safety and environmental protection is performing according to the company policy? How identify nonconformities ashore and onboard ship and correct them to meet and maintain the level of requirements of the ISM Code? How to deal with accidents, incidents and near-misses? How to prepare the review of the company safety management system?
